



## EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

### CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS

The Fijian Government invites expressions of interest from reputable construction firms for construction of public buildings including hospitals, health care facilities and schools.

The scope of works will include general construction of new buildings or upgrading of the existing buildings as per designs approved by the Government in areas affected by Tropical Cyclone Winston. The contractor will be required to mobilise as soon as approval is given by the Government.

To achieve economies of scale, contractors may be required to simultaneously construct on multiple sites in a similar location. Following assessments of buildings damaged by Tropical Cyclone Winston, construction designs will be prepared and shortlisted contractors will be invited to submit cost proposals.

#### **Interested contractors must submit the following:**

1. Detailed company or firm profile
2. Copies of relevant business registrations, certificates and licences, including evidence of FNPF and tax compliance (if applicable)
3. Last two years of certified financial reports (audited reports if available)
4. Current resource capability
5. Experience – significant past projects with contract values, including work at remote locations
6. List of current projects with contract values
7. Contractors must also state bargaining leverage if more than two buildings are required to be built or upgraded at a single location or within 5-10 km

Contractors will be selected based on task appreciation, ability to mobilise quickly, relevant experience, past performance, proposed personnel and financial capacity. The relevant documents pertaining to the building designs will be distributed to shortlisted contractors.


